Gianfranco Gervasio

The youngest son of John and Stefanie Gervasio, Gianfranco was born and raised in Lodi, is a graduate of Saddle Brook High School, attended Bergen Community College and is employed by the Bank of New Jersey where he was promoted from teller to branch manager. He was an avid supporter of the Garfield UNICO by attending numerous events and eventually planning on becoming a member himself.

On July 4, 2009 Gianfranco seriously injured the C5 vertebra in his neck in a swimming pool accident, leaving him without movement in his lower extremities. After his injury he spent 4 weeks in Hackensack University Hospital in the Intensive Care Unit. He is currently at Kessler Rehabilitation Center in West Orange, NJ where he will spend the next sixty days.

Future Expenses

Once Gianfranco returns home there will be many non-medical costs involved for his care and daily life. Costs such as a motorized wheel chair, handicapped accessible van, and many renovations required to his home will be necessary to make every day activities possible for Gianfranco. Unfortunately for Gianfranco and his family, these costs are additional expenses beyond what the average insurance benefit covers.
